NRA Range Safety Officer Course Scheduled Date: March 29, 2014

Location: 2142 Simpson Lane, Richmond, Kentucky 40475

Pre-Requisites: None

Objective:

To develop NRA Range Safety Officers who possess the **knowledge**, **skills**, and **attitudes** essential to organizing, conducting, and supervising safe shooting activities and range operations.

Description:

This course is *nine hours* long and is conducted by an NRA Chief Range Safety Officer (CRSO) in a classroom and at a shooting facility. Range Safety Officer candidates will learn roles and responsibilities of an RSO; Range Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs); range inspection; range rules; range briefings; emergency procedures; and firearm stoppages and malfunctions. Each Range Safety Officer Candidate will receive an RSO Student Study Guide, a Basic Firearm Training Program brochure, an NRA Gun Safety Rules brochure, an Instructor Application/Course Evaluation form. (Lesson Plan 10-05, revised 01-10).
